## NOMINATIONS & CAMPAIGNING

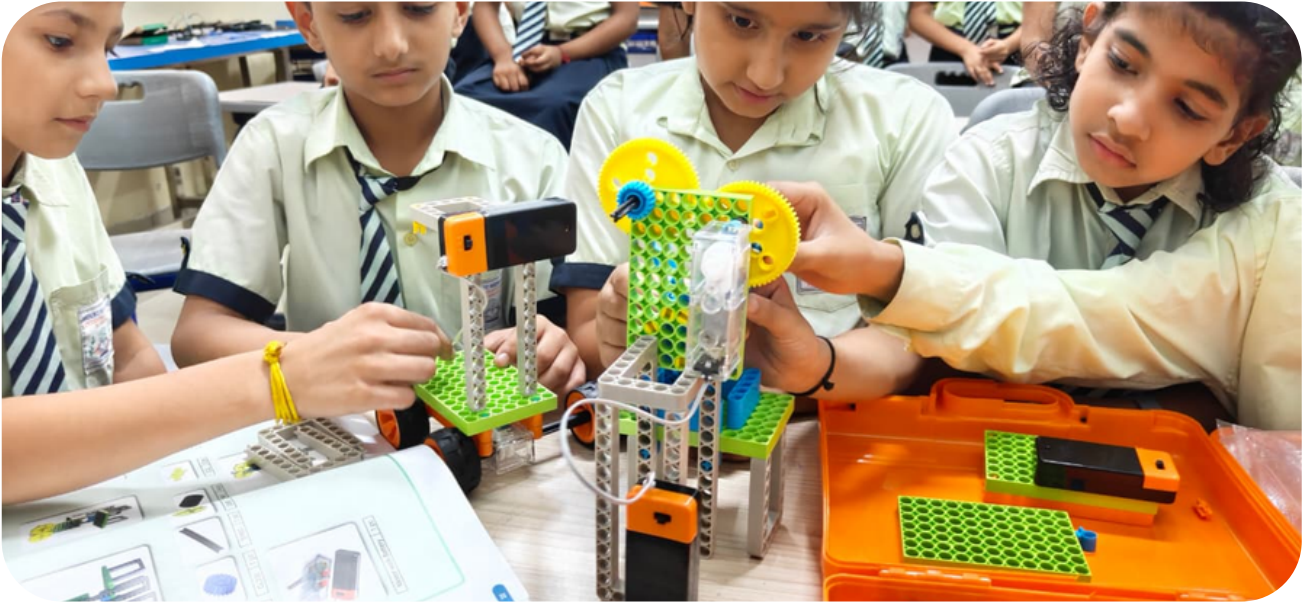
